



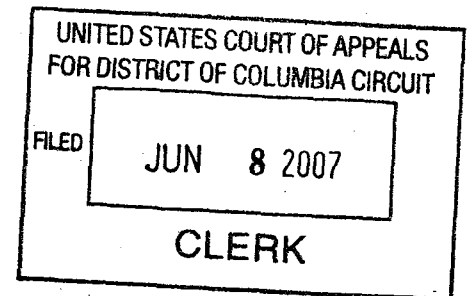

Upon consideration of intervenor UNITE HERE's motion for leave to file a response to the petition for rehearing and rehearing en banc, and the lodged response thereto, it is


